### It all began in 1990....

Our community in Port Klang, near Selangor in West Malaysia, was formally inaugurated in July 1991 when the *foundation members*—Sisters Hannah Naidu, Teresa Tan and Assunta Low moved from premises generously loaned by the parish, into St. Joseph's, a corner terrace-house opposite the railway workers' quarters.

During the 25 years in Port Klang, the sisters were engaged in multi-faceted ministry in favour of the materially poor. Their various endeavours include Educare, a Learning Centre for under-privileged children.

Fr. Michael Raymond OFM Cap in his homily reminded us the words of St. Francis of Assisi: *"Let us begin again, for up till now we have done little or nothing."*

After Mass, the celebration continued with a meal and entertainment by children and youth from Educare and the Parish.
