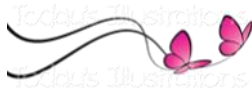
Ave Verum Corpus

May the choirs of angels

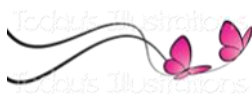
Come to greet you.
